Key Points from April 2021



Goondiwindi's has seen some good stable growth into 2021, 20% on average from 2020.




The Reservation Window has seen a 45% from 2019 and has been growing steadily the past 4 months.

Average Occupancy Rate

The occupancy rate is the ratio between the number of occupied rooms and the number of rooms offered that are open.






INSIGHT

There has been a slight decline in the past 4 months, with April ending on a 44% occupancy level. This is a 34% decrease from 2019.

Reservation Window (days)

The reservation window is the period of time between when the reservation is made by the guests and the actual arrival date to the destination. For example, a reservation of 36 means that people are booking accommodation on average 36 days before they arrive at the destination.





Although the Reservation Window is down from 2020 at 36 days, it's seen a 45% increase from 2019 and has been following a similar upward trend for the past 4 months.

Length of Stay


Length of stay is the amount of time(days) that was booked at the accommodation.





Average Daily Rate

The average daily rate (ADR) measures the average rental revenue earned for an occupied room per day.







Although Aprils ADR of \$104 is down from last year, the past two months have shown a steady growth.

The source market demonstrates which LGA visitors are travelling from, focusing on the top 7 for the month of April.






INSIGHT

The LGA's with the most amount of devices seen within the Goondiwindi region in April 2021 were Toowoomba with 10.5%, Brisbane with 10% and Gold Coast, Southern Downs and Moreton Bay all close together around 5% each.

Day of the Week

These graphs visualise which days of the week people are visiting the most for the month of April.






INSIGHT

Interestingly, the most common days to visit in 2020 were Wednesday and Thursday - probably due to COVID. Now into 2021, the most common is Friday through to Sunday contributing to 45% of visitation for the week.
